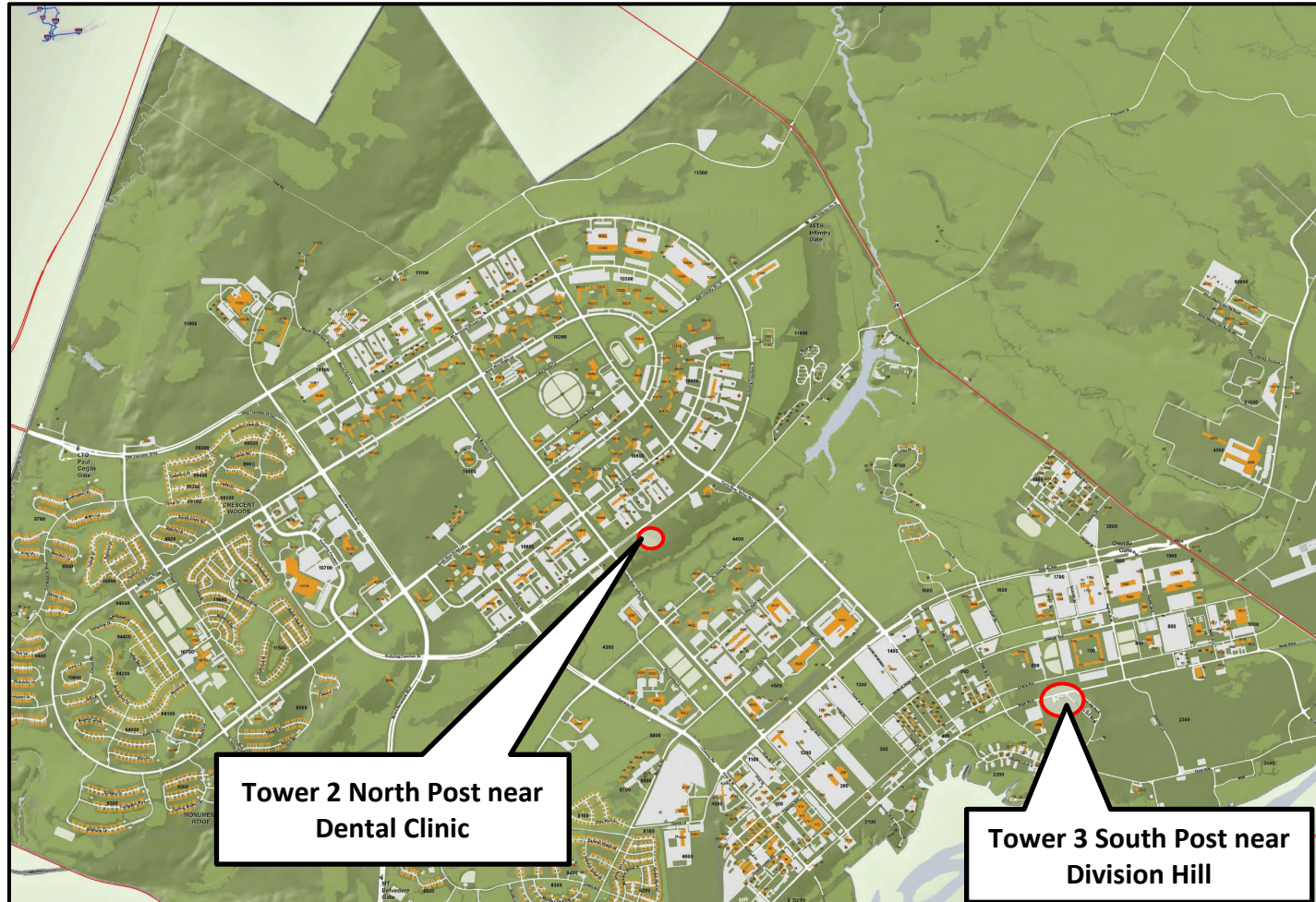

Striping of installation roads & parking lots occurs every year, be cautious and aware of crews across the installation typically June-August

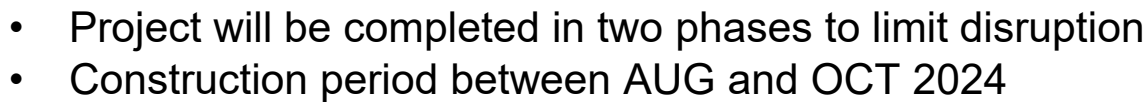

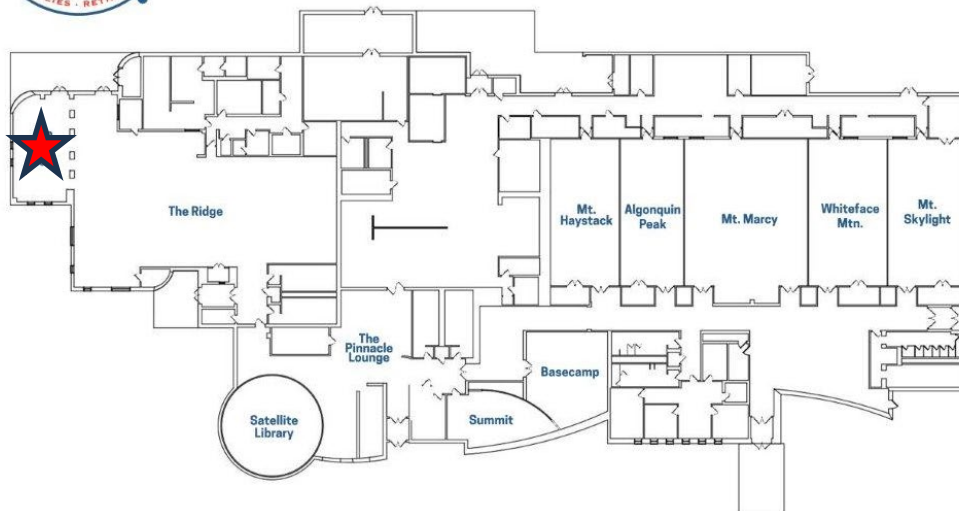


- **Congressionally mandated** inspection
